

Press Release Saturday Sept 12/09

Rocky Mountain Raceway Park.

Thunder at the Rock returned to Rocky Mountain Raceway Park just south of Aldersyde on Saturday night. Fans from all over Southern Alberta came to see who could gain more points towards the year end points total on the ¼ mile high banked dirt oval. Four classes would entertain racing fans on this beautiful September evening, IMCA Modified, Hobby Stocks, Sportsman Sprints and Claimer/Stock 4.

The IMCA Modified continued to excite fans with their wheel to wheel action. First place in the feature 25 lap race would be won by #72 J.R. Bruins. Second was won by # 62 Kirby Zielinski. After winning the first two heats #9 Roger Bonneville would take third.

The Hobby Stock's continued to entertain the fans. At this point the title of track champion is still up for grabs. Gaining points in the standings would be # 10 Cody Beaton finishing first. Battling for second was #6 Darrell Belanger and #16 Cody Lee finished in third.

The evening saw one of the most amazing crashes in the Sportsman Sprints heat race. New comer to dirt racing # 25 Troy Maschke would flip his car several times before landing uninjured. Finishing the main race in the same order they were sitting in the points stand was #397 Kyle Bates, following in second place was #8 Pierre Guyon while #44W sprint car driven by rookie Shawn White would finish in third.

Claimers or Stock 4 class saw a bit of bumping and grinding in the end causing a dispute for the feature race. The race will be reviewed on Sept 22/09 and then the results will be published.
