THUNDER AT THE ROCK

The grandstands thundered for the first time in September at Rocky Mountain Raceway Park as competitors from the Hobby Stock Trucks, Part Source Hobby Stocks, I.M.C.A. Modifieds and Sportsman Sprint Cars took to the high banks. Less than ideal weather conditions brought the racing action to a halt before the I.M.C.A. Modifieds and the Sportsman Sprint Cars could begin their feature races. Rainfall made the racing surface slippery and too dangerous to compete on.

#58 Calvin Fuhriman, the 2007 Hobby Stock Truck Champion, took over the lead in the Truck feature event at midpoint after starting from last position to win the race and further his lead in the championship points race for the 2008 racing season . Finishing in second place was #7 Curtis Bigelow of Brooks Alberta and third place went to #.08 Sarah Duffy.

The Part Source Hobby Stocks had thirteen competitors start the feature race on the Rocks ¼ dirt high bank. After the smoke cleared only 10 cars remained and leading them to the checkered flag was the #68 of Garth Dushanek. Second place went to #50 of Kevin Cole followed closely by #11 Greg Beaton. Only 2 more races in the 2008 season remain for the part Source Hobby Stock competitors and once again the championship points battle is very close.

After running heat races and perfecting their race setups the competitors of the I.M.C.A. Modifieds and the Sportsman Sprint Cars were denied feature race excitement by Mother Nature when the skies opened up and turned what was an excellent race surface into an undriveable mud bog.

The Thunder returns to the Rock on Saturday September 20th with racing action from the Claimer Cars, Hobby Stock trucks, Part Source Hobby Stocks and Sportsman Sprints. Be there!!!!
